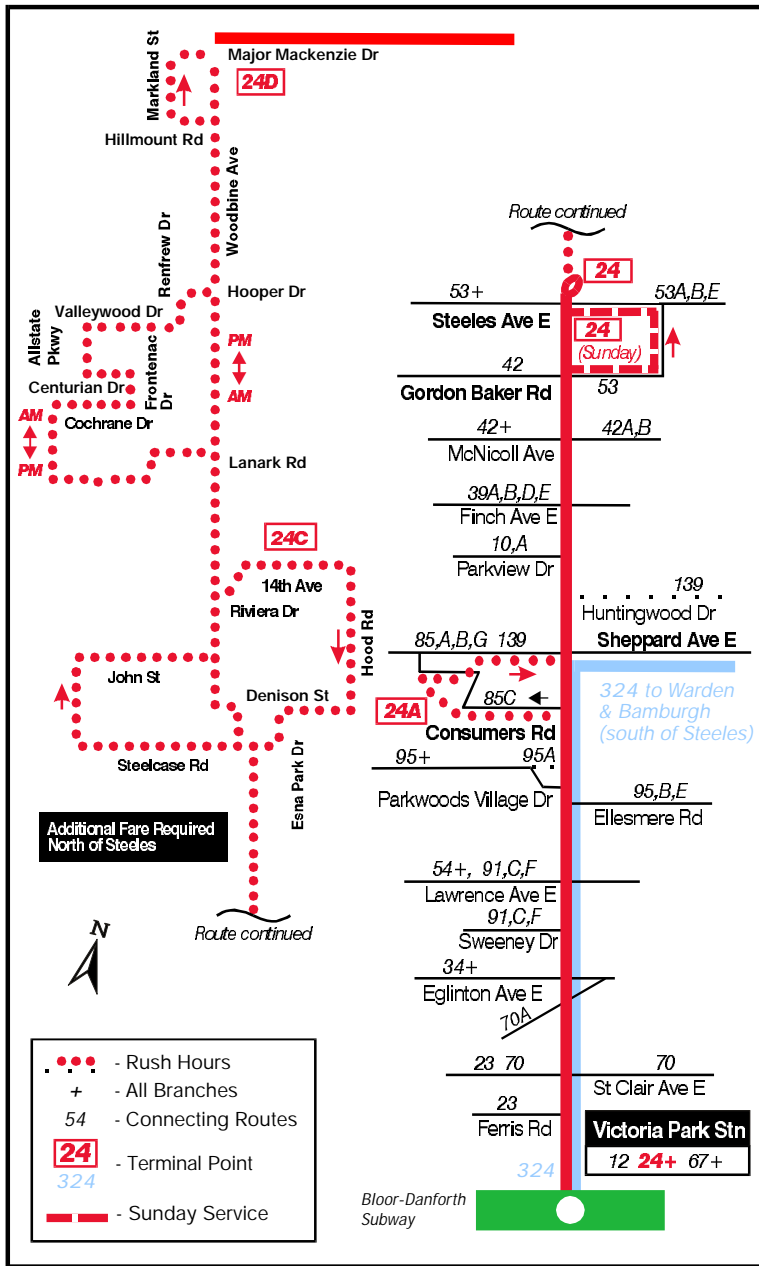




24 Victoria Park



Effective September 3, 2000

Extension to Major Mackenzie Drive

The 24D Victoria Park "Highway 7" branch will be extended, at the request of Markham Transit, to serve new residential and commercial areas. The service, which operates during the peak periods from Monday to Friday, will be improved from every 32 min to every 30 min.

24C and 24D buses will continue to run every 30 minutes during the rush hours, but departure times will be adjusted to provide a more evenly spaced combined service.

Service Change

Improved Fall Service will be implemented, replacing seasonal summer service reductions.

- 24 - Victoria Park Stn ⇄ Steeles
- 24A - Victoria Park Stn ⇄ Sheppard via Consumers
- 24C - Victoria Park Stn ⇄ 14th Avenue
- 24D - Victoria Park Stn ⇄ Major Mackenzie

Monday - Friday (24: 4:50 a.m. - 1:25 a.m.);(24A: 5:35 a.m. - 6:00 p.m.);(24C: 5:43 a.m. - 6:52 p.m.);(24D: 5:55 a.m. - 6:49 p.m.)

- 24 branch runs every 7 - 8 minutes during the morning rush, every 9 minutes during the early evening, every 10 minutes midday, every 15 minutes during the afternoon rush, and every 16 minutes during the late evening.
- 24A branch runs every 15 minutes during the afternoon rush, and every 17 minutes during the morning rush.
- 24C branch runs every 30 minutes during the morning and the afternoon rush.
- 24D branch runs every 30 minutes during the morning and the afternoon rush.

Saturday (5:20 a.m. - 1:24 a.m.)

- 24 branch runs every 10 minutes during the day, every 12 minutes during the late evening, every 13 - 14 minutes during early evening, and every 15 minutes during the early morning.
- 24A, C, D branches have no Saturday service.

Sunday (7:17 a.m. - 1:16 a.m.)

- 24 branch runs every 12 minutes during the afternoon, every 16 minutes during the morning, and every 20 minutes during the early morning, early evening and the late evening.
- 24A, C, D branches have no Sunday service.

All night service is provided by route 324 (see map)

Request Stop Program

Allows women travelling alone on buses between 9:00 p.m. - 5:00 a.m. to ask the driver to let them get off the bus at locations between the regular TTC stops.

TTC's Blue Night Network

Service is provided from approximately 1:30 a.m. to 5:00 a.m. on a basic network of routes throughout Toronto, at stops with reflective blue bands. Service is provided every 30 minutes or better.
