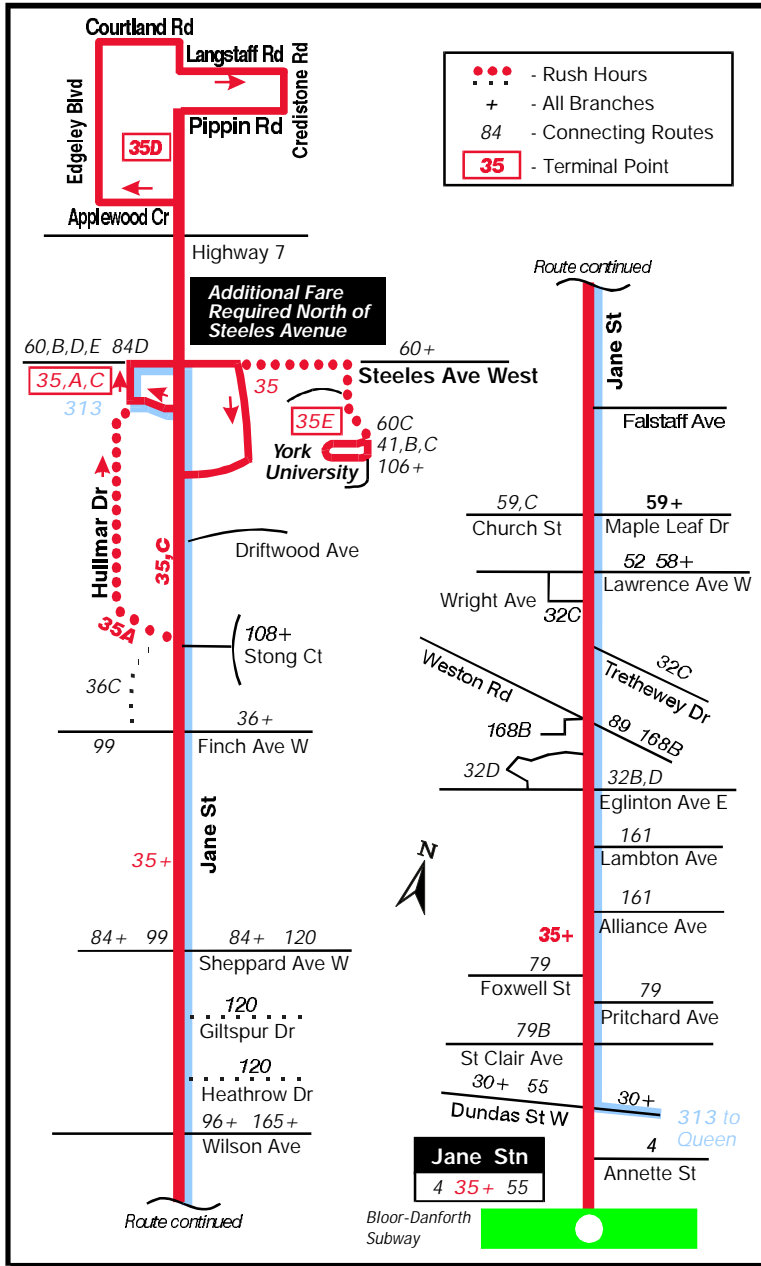




35 Jane



Effective September 3, 2000

Revised routing

Two trips on this route in the afternoon peak period from Monday to Friday will start from Nelson A. Boylen C.I., on Falstaff Avenue (one travelling north, the other travelling south on Jane), just west of Culford Road, at approximately 3:20 p.m. This is to partially replace the 163 Rustic Rd route.

Branch Service Summary

- 35 - Jane St ⇄ Steeles & Pioneer Village
- 35A - Jane St ⇄ Steeles via Hullmar
- 35C - Jane St ⇄ Steeles via Peter Kaiser
- 35D - Jane St ⇄ Langstaff Rd
- 35E - Jane St ⇄ York University (Express)

Monday – Friday (35: 8:17 a.m. - 9:17 p.m.);(35A: 5:20 a.m. - 6:44 p.m.);(35C: 4:25 a.m. - 2:15 a.m.);(35D: 5:30 a.m. - 9:40 p.m.);(35E: 7:08 a.m. - 6:06 p.m.)

- 35 branch runs every 13 minutes during the midday, every 15 minutes during early evening, and every 17 - 18 minutes during the afternoon.
- 35A branch runs every 15 minutes during the morning, and every 17 - 18 minutes during the midday.
- 35C branch runs every 3 - 4 minutes during the morning rush, every 12 minutes during the late evening, every 17 - 18 minutes during the afternoon rush, every 26 minutes during the midday, and every 30 minutes during the early evening.
- 35D branch runs every 15 minutes during the morning rush, every 17 - 18 minutes during the afternoon rush, every 26 minutes during the midday, and every 30 minutes during the early evening.
- 35E branch runs every 16 - 17 minutes during the afternoon rush, and every 20 minutes during the morning rush.

Saturday (35: 8:21 a.m. - 9:53 p.m.);(35C: 4:27 a.m. - 2:15 a.m.); (35D: 6:15 a.m. - 6:32 p.m.)

- 35 branch runs every 13 minutes during morning and afternoon and every 15 minutes during the early evening.
- 35C branch runs every 7 minutes during the early morning, every 12 minutes during the late evening, every 15 minutes during the early evening, and every 26 minutes during the morning and afternoon.
- 35D branch runs every 26 minutes during the morning and afternoon, and every 28 minutes during the early morning.

Sunday (35: 8:51 a.m. - 9:50 p.m.);(35C: 4:27 a.m. - 2:15 a.m.)

- 35 branch runs, every 13 - 14 minutes during the morning, every 14 - 15 minutes during the afternoon and every 22 minutes during the early evening.
- 35C branch runs every 13 - 14 minutes during the morning, every 14 - 15 minutes during the afternoon, every 15 minutes during the late evening, every 22 minutes during the early evening, and every 30 minutes during the early morning.
