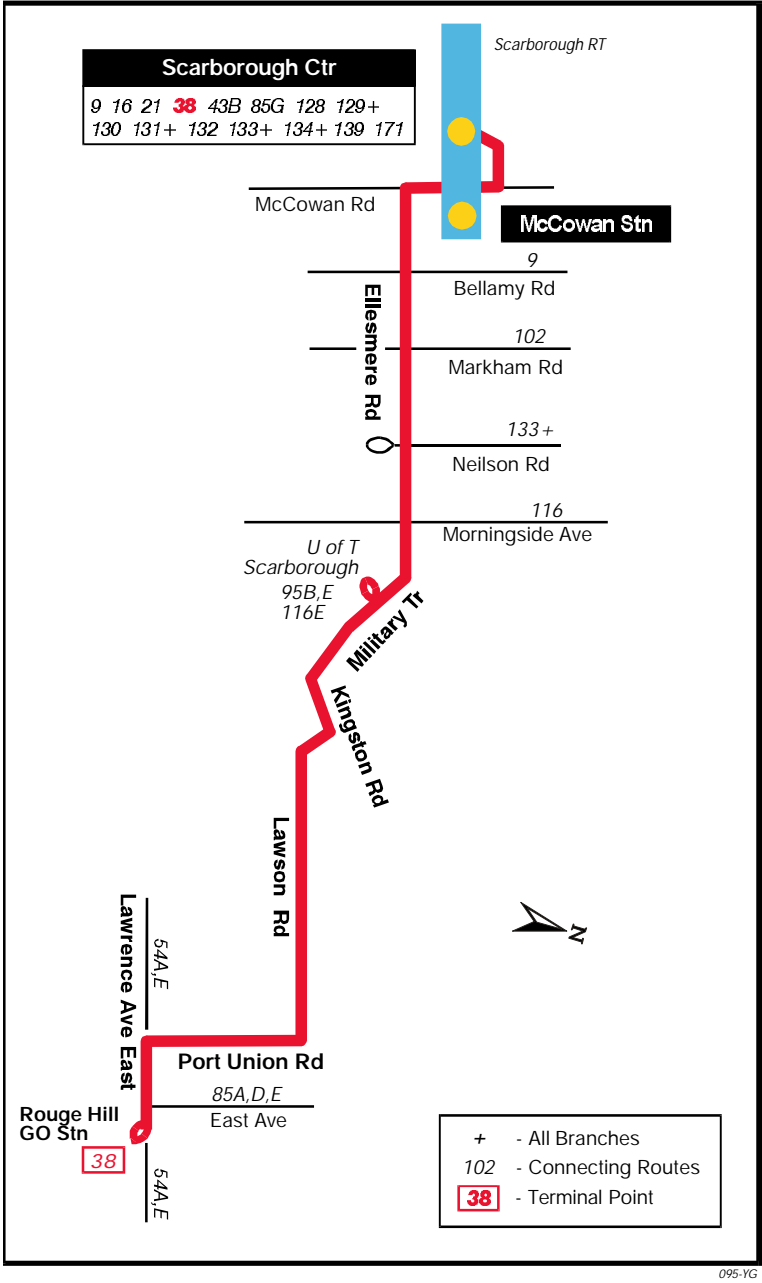




# 38 Highland Creek



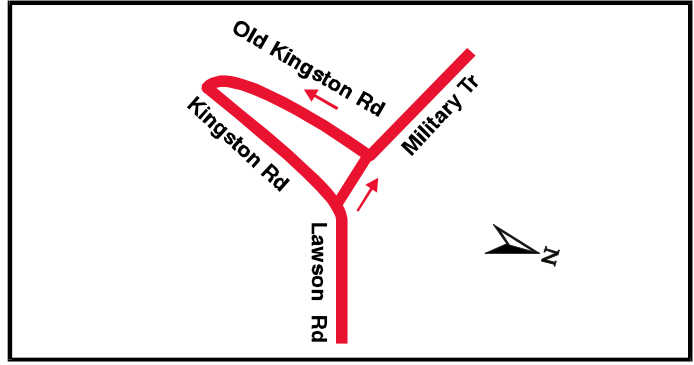
**Effective September 3, 2000**

### New route

The new 38 Highland Creek route will replace part of the present 95 York Mills route, and will provide a new connection from Scarborough Centre Station to the University of Toronto at Scarborough. This new route will be scheduled together with the present 133 Neilson route to provide an evenly-spaced frequent service on Ellesmere Road between Scarborough Centre Station and Neilson Road.

### Temporary route change

The road construction project at the Highland Creek Overpass will affect the new 38 Highland Creek route until late November. The route will be diverted, eastbound only, via Old Kingston Road and Kingston Road around the construction when required.



## Service Summary

### Monday - Friday (5:04 a.m. - 1:47 a.m.)

- Buses run every 11 minutes during the morning rush, every 12 minutes during the afternoon rush, every 15 minutes midday and the early evening, and every 20 minutes during the late evening.

### Saturday (5:51 a.m. - 12:57 a.m.)

- Buses run every 12 minutes during the morning and afternoon, every 15 minutes during early evening, every 17 minutes during the early morning, and every 20 minutes during the late evening.

### Sunday

- There is no Sunday service.

### Request Stop Program

Allows women travelling alone on buses between 9:00 p.m. - 5:00 a.m. to ask the driver to let them get off the bus at locations between the regular TTC stops.

### TTC's Blue Night Network

Service is provided from approximately 1:30 a.m. to 5:00 a.m. on a basic network of routes throughout Toronto, at stops with reflective blue bands. Service is provided every 30 minutes or better.
