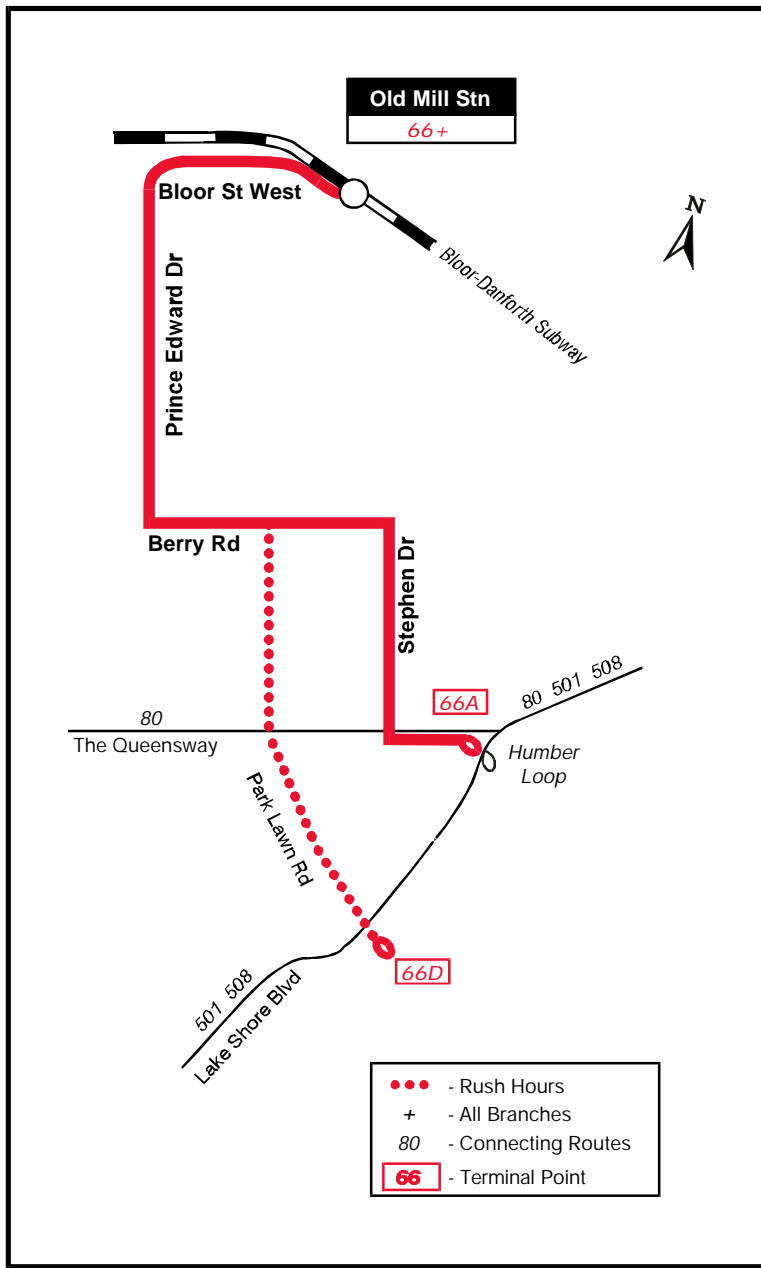

Call 416-393-4636. Operator assistance (8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.), recorded and fax information 24 hours, seven days a week.

Request Stop Program

Allows women travelling alone on buses between 9:00 p.m. - 5:00 a.m. to ask the driver to let them get off the bus at locations between the regular TTC stops.

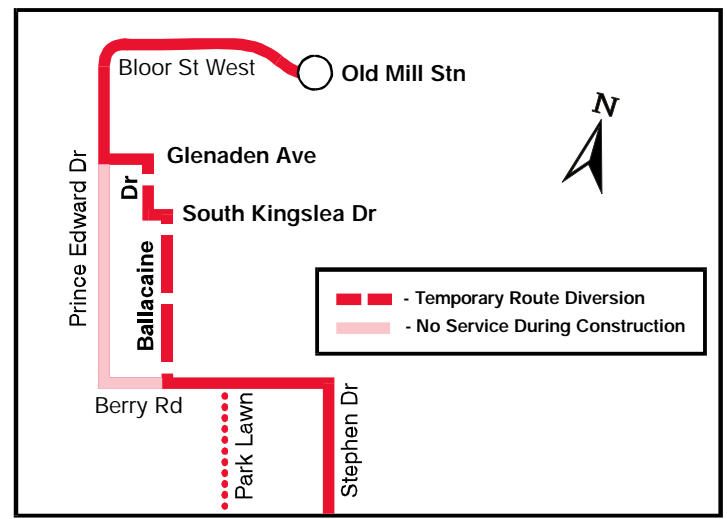
TTC's Blue Night Network

Service is provided from approximately 1:30 a.m. to 5:00 a.m. on a basic network of routes throughout Toronto, at stops with reflective blue bands. Service is provided every 30 minutes or better.

April 30, 2000 Service Changes

Route change – Temporary route change

The route will be diverted, at all times of the week, as a result of the City of Toronto project to rebuild Prince Edward Drive, between Sunnylea Avenue and Berry Road. Buses will divert, both ways via Glenaden, South Kingslea and Ballacaine. Additional running time will be added because of the diversion. During the morning peak period, the service west of Park Lawn Road will change from every 7 to 8 minutes to every 10 min, and during the afternoon peak period, the service on each branch will change from every 8 to 9 minutes to every 11 min.



Service Summary

66A ⇄ Humber Loop – Old Mill Stn

66D ⇄ Lake Shore – Old Mill Stn

Route 66 PRINCE EDWARD service operates on a weekday from approximately 5:20 a.m. till 12:45 a.m. During rush hour, this service is every 10 minutes or better and non-rush hour it is every 15 – 30 minutes.

Saturday service runs every 15 – 30 minutes from approximately 6:00 a.m. till 12:45 a.m.

Sunday service runs every 15 – 30 minutes from approximately 8:45 a.m. till 11:45 a.m.
