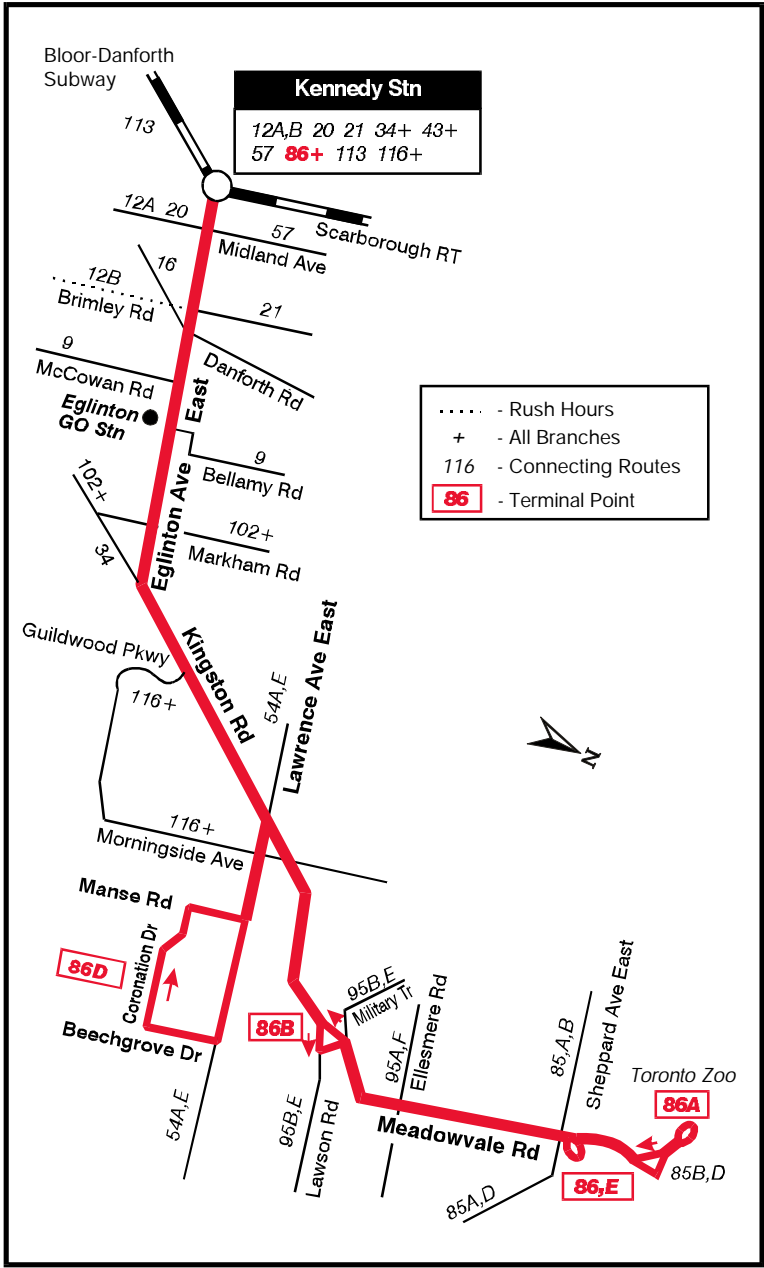

Route change – Seasonal route extension to Toronto Zoo

The route will be extended to the Toronto Zoo on Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays, until approximately 8:30 p.m. Buses will follow the same routing to the zoo as they do from Monday to Friday. There will be no change to the interval between buses on the route. The route extension will be operated until Labour Day, Monday, September 4, 2000.

Schedule change – Hours of service to Toronto Zoo

Later service will be provided from the Toronto Zoo in the early evening from Monday to Friday, to match the later closing time of the zoo, at 7:30 p.m. The last trip on the will leave from the zoo at approximately 8:30 p.m.

Route 86 SCARBOROUGH service operates on a weekday from approximately 4:50 a.m. till 1:23 a.m. During rush hour, this service is every 10 minutes or better and non-rush hour it is every 10 – 14 minutes.

Saturday service runs every 10 – 17 minutes from approximately 4:40 a.m. till 1:01 a.m.

Sunday service runs every 13 – 22 minutes from approximately 5:50 a.m. till 1:06 a.m.

 Service is provided from approximately 1:30 a.m. to 5:00 a.m. on a basic network of routes throughout Toronto, at stops with reflective blue bands. Service is provided every 30 minutes or better.
