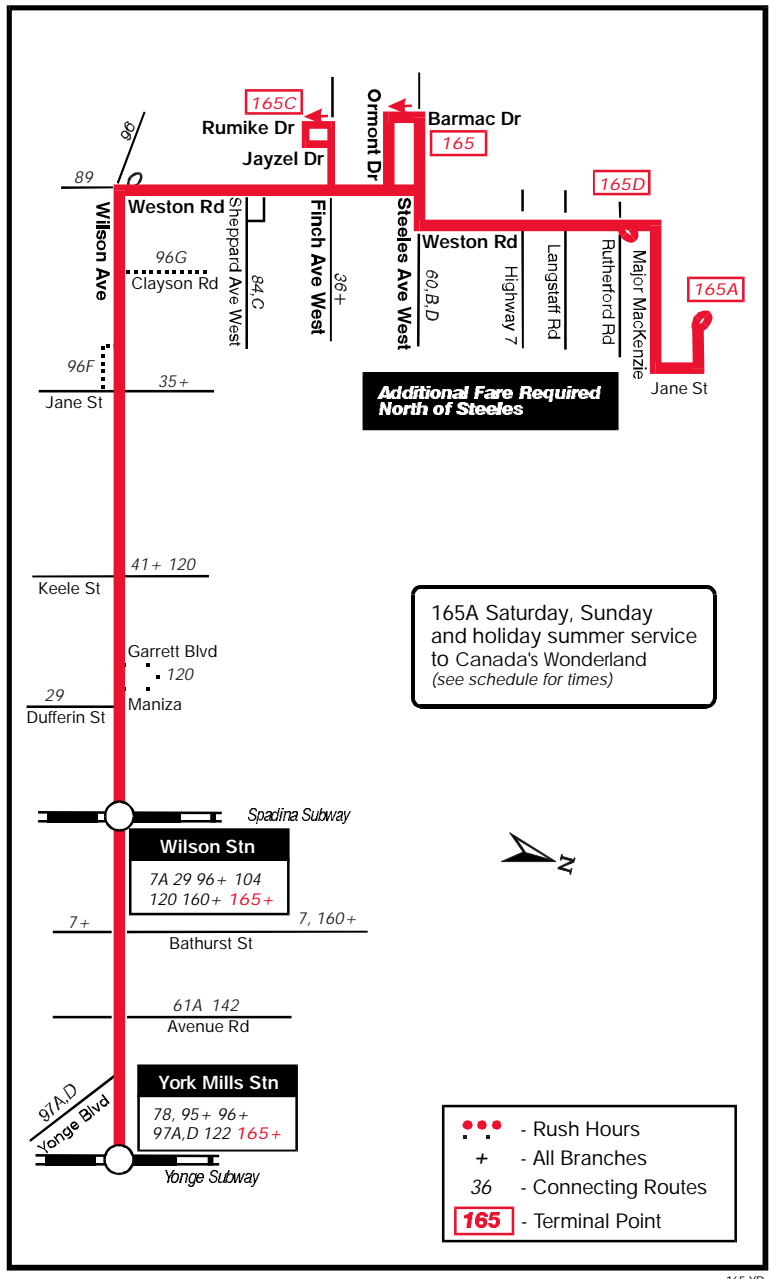

April 30, 2000 Service Changes

Route change - Seasonal route extension

At the request of Vaughan Transit, service will be extended to Canada's Wonderland, on Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays, from April 30 to Thanksgiving Day, October 9. The extended service will operate from 9:35 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. on Saturdays, and from 9:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. on Sundays and holidays.

The first trip will arrive at the park at approximately 9:34 a.m. on Saturdays, and at 9:27 a.m. on Sundays and holidays. The last trip will leave from the park at 10:40 p.m. on Saturdays, and at 7:23 p.m. (to York Mills Stn, with a later trip at 8:09 p.m. to Steeles Avenue only) on Sundays and holidays.

Buses to the park will operate every 30 minutes during the daytime on Saturdays, and approximately every 50 minutes during the evening on Saturdays and the daytime on Sundays and holidays. Trip times in Toronto will not change.

Customers travelling on 165 Weston Rd North buses north of Steeles Avenue are required to pay a valid South York Region transit fare.

Route 165 WESTON ROAD NORTH service operates on a weekday from approximately 5:22 a.m. till 1:50 a.m. During rush hour, this service is every 10 minutes or better and non-rush hour it is every 12 - 20 minutes.

Saturday service runs every 15 - 23 minutes from approximately 5:31 a.m. till 2:00 a.m.

 Allows women travelling alone on buses between 9:00 p.m. - 5:00 a.m. to ask the driver to let them get off the bus at locations between the regular TTC stops.

TTC's Blue Night Network
 Service is provided from approximately 1:30 a.m. to 5:00 a.m. on a basic network of routes throughout Toronto, at stops with reflective blue bands. Service is provided every 30 minutes or better.
