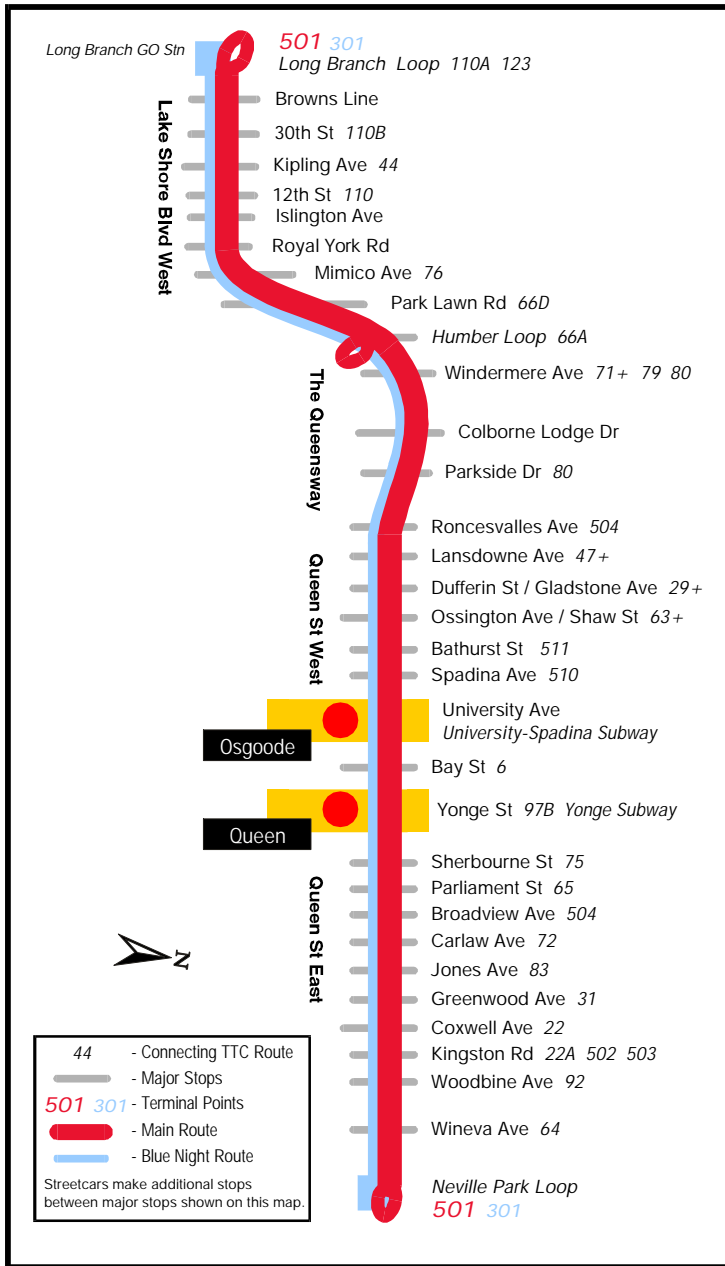




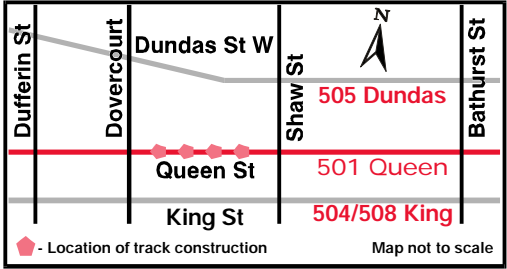
501 Queen



Effective September 3, 2000

Track reconstruction
Track construction between Shaw Street and Fennings Street (one block east of Dovercourt Road), and at the intersection of Shaw Street and Queen Street, will begin. Streetcars on the 501/301 Queen route will be diverted when required. Additional time will be added to the schedules to accommodate the diversion.

There will be no replacement bus service during this project. Customers who normally use the streetcar stops on Queen Street will have to walk to King Street or Dundas Street.
