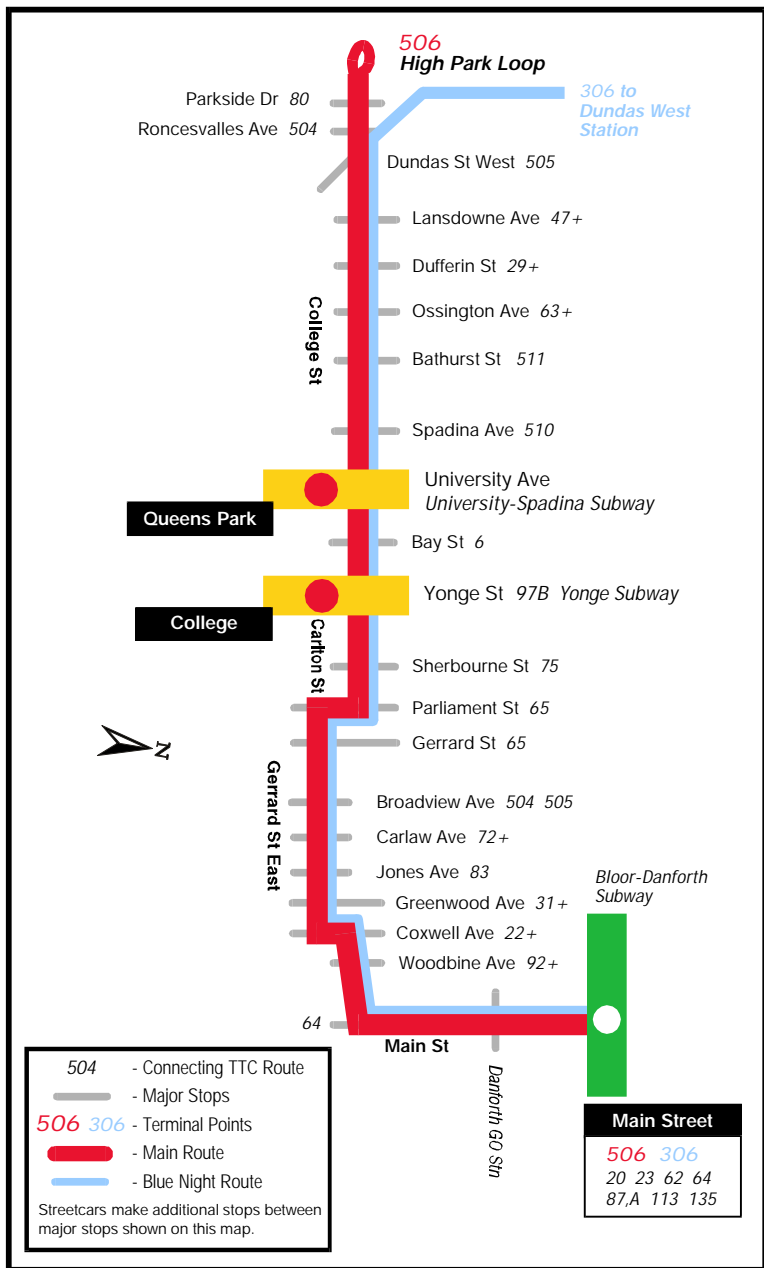




# 506 Carlton

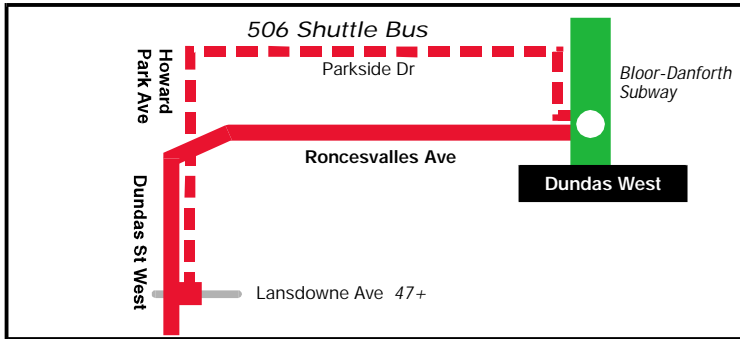


## Effective September 3, 2000

**Temporary route change Streetcar track reconstruction**  
 A project to rebuild the track at High Park Loop will require a change to the 506 CARLTON route. For approximately two weeks when the track is under construction, streetcars will be diverted away from High Park, and a replacement bus service will be operated, as shown below.

**Service increase**  
 Service will be increased during the midday from Monday to Friday, to reduce overcrowding. Service will be improved from every 6 min 20 s to every 5 min 45 s.

**Service change**  
 Improved Fall Service will be implemented, replacing seasonal summer service reductions.



## Service Summary

**Monday – Friday (5:30 a.m. - 12:07 a.m.)**  
 Streetcars run every 3 - 4 minutes during the morning rush, every 4 - 5 minutes during the afternoon rush, every 5 - 6 minutes midday, every 9 minutes during the early evening, and every 11 minutes during the late evening.

**Saturday (5:30 a.m. - 12:07 a.m.)**  
 Streetcars run every 6 minutes during the afternoon, every 7 minutes during the morning, every 7 - 8 minutes during the early morning, every 8 - 9 minutes during early evening, and every 11 minutes during the late evening.

**Sunday (5:30 a.m. - 12:07 a.m.)**  
 Streetcars run every 7 - 8 minutes during the morning and afternoon, every 10 minutes during the early morning, every 11 minutes during early evening and late evening.

All night service is provided by route 306 (see map).

**How to TTC to where you're going?**  
 Call 416-393-4636. Operator assistance (8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.); recorded and fax information 24 hours, seven days a week.

**Request Stop Program**  
 Allows women travelling alone on buses between 9:00 p.m. - 5:00 a.m. to ask the driver to let them get off the bus at locations between the regular TTC stops.

**TTC's Blue Night Network**  
 Service is provided from approximately 1:30 a.m. to 5:00 a.m. on a basic network of routes throughout Toronto, at stops with reflective blue bands. Service is provided every 30 minutes or better.
