

RESERVING YOUR CHARTER

Phone the TTC Charter Office at (416) 393-7880 to reserve your PCC streetcar charter. Please have the following details available:

- date of charter
- pick up location and time
- return location and time
- suggested route

A minimum of two weeks advance notice is necessary, and the requested service will not be available during rush hours from Monday to Friday (7:00 – 9:30 AM and 3:30 – 7:00 PM). Charter route is subject to access to streetcar tracks and will be authorized by the TTC. If, in the interest of safety and passenger convenience, a change in the routing is necessary, after the charter has been booked, the TTC reserves the right to implement such change.

COST

The cost to charter a PCC streetcar and driver is as follows:

3 Hour minimum period (+GST 7%)	\$376.00
Each additional hour (+GST 7%)	\$88.00

NOTE: The TTC operator does not provide any commentary. If this service is required, the client is responsible to make arrangements for a step-on guide.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Rental of PCC streetcar strictly subject to availability.
- In the event of a mechanical breakdown, the TTC reserves the right to replace the PCC streetcar with a regular streetcar.
- The loading and unloading of any personal possessions and/or equipment is the responsibility of the chartering party.
- Any damage to the vehicle, caused by the passengers, will be charged by the carrier to the chartering party.
- Cancellation charges of \$124.00 + GST will apply to all charters cancelled later than 11 a.m. on the day prior to date of service.
- Unauthorized signage or any other object displayed on exterior and interior of vehicle is prohibited.
- OPERATORS DO NOT PARK IN RESTRICTED AREAS.
- Consumption of alcohol prohibited by law. Food and non-alcoholic beverages are permitted on PCC streetcar.
- MAXIMUM PASSENGERS: 65 TOTAL (there are only 46 seats in the PCC streetcar)
- The TTC reserves the right to cancel any and all charter services without notice and the TTC shall not be responsible for any losses incurred as a result of such cancellation.

Payment in advance by cheque or money order to be received no less than five working days before date of service. Please make cheque payable to the Toronto Transit Commission.

HISTORY

The Toronto Transportation Commission, now known as the Toronto Transit Commission (TTC) introduced the Presidents' Conference Committee (PCC) streetcar to Toronto transit patrons in 1938. This type of vehicle would go on to serve as the backbone of the transit system until 1954, when the Yonge subway line opened. A total of 745 PCC streetcars – the largest such fleet in the world – served the residents of Toronto from the PCC streetcar's inception until December 8, 1995, when PCC streetcar service ended.

Two vintage PCCs: #4500 and #4549 have been retained for special charter and sightseeing service.

Over the 57 years the PCC streetcar served transit users, Toronto has changed from a nondescript small city to the cosmopolitan and world-class community it has become today.



DESIGN YOUR OWN ROUTE

The TTC operates on a network of streetcar tracks in the City. When the route you have selected is approved by the TTC, the charter will operate in conjunction with scheduled service. Enroute stops and breaks in the itinerary will not be possible if delays result in scheduled service. The PCC streetcar operator has the final authority in operating the charter service.

SUGGESTED SIGHTSEEING TOUR*

The Old Town of York and Today's Modern Toronto

The tour will start on York Street just South of Queen (Sheraton Centre Hotel), and proceed on the following streets: East on Queen, North on Church, East on Dundas, North on Parliament, East on Gerrard, South on Broadview, West on Queen/West on King, North on Spadina, (to Bloor-Danforth subway loop) South on Spadina, East on Queen's Quay (to Union Station loop), West on Queen's Quay, North on Spadina, East on Queen, South on Church, West on Richmond, North on York to drop-off point.
