Building Demolition

Site of TTC's New Mount Dennis Bus Garage
Industry Street near Ray Avenue
Beginning late February 2005

DEMOLITION

Beginning late February 2005, the Toronto Transit Commission (TTC) will start demolition of the four vacated industrial buildings located in the vicinity of 121 Industry Street, bounded by Ray Avenue, Touchstone Drive and the CN Railway line. This work is in preparation for the construction of the TTC's new bus garage. Under this particular contract, the four buildings will be demolished to grade. The site will remain secured with a chain-link fence along the perimeter of the property once demolition is completed. This work is scheduled for completion by the end of July 2005.

WORK HOURS

General work hours are between 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday to Friday. However, as demolition work is normally carried out during daytime hours, and is subject to weather conditions, the contractor may work on Saturdays, to complete the work as quickly as possible.

ACCESS

All access on Industry Street will be maintained during this work. The contractor's trailer offices will be located within the property.

FUTURE WORK

Notification will be provided prior to construction of the new bus garage.

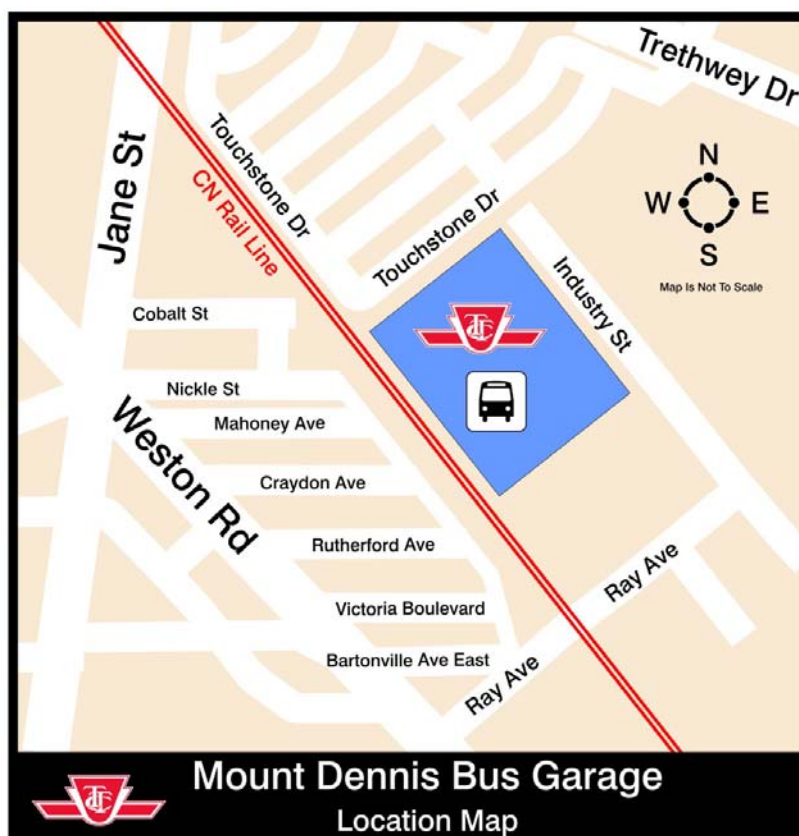
