

## 2020 Finch West LRT Construction Overview

Major construction activities will increase in 2020 on the Finch West Light Rail Transit (LRT) project.

Mosaic Transit Group, our contractor, will be working in several sections simultaneously this year across the alignment.

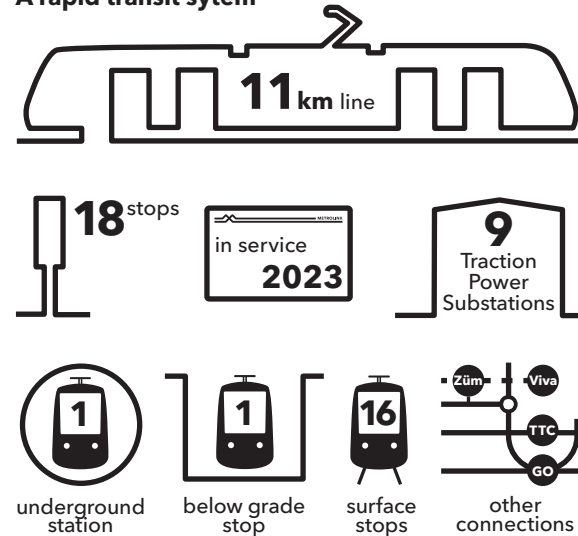
We recognize that designing and building the Finch West LRT will have an impact on the local community, motorists, transit users, pedestrians and cyclists and will work hard to anticipate, understand and manage those impacts.

For public and workers' safety, lane closures or lane reductions will occur. Pedestrian access will be maintained. Some TTC bus stops may be moved. Changes to traffic and transit will be communicated to the public.

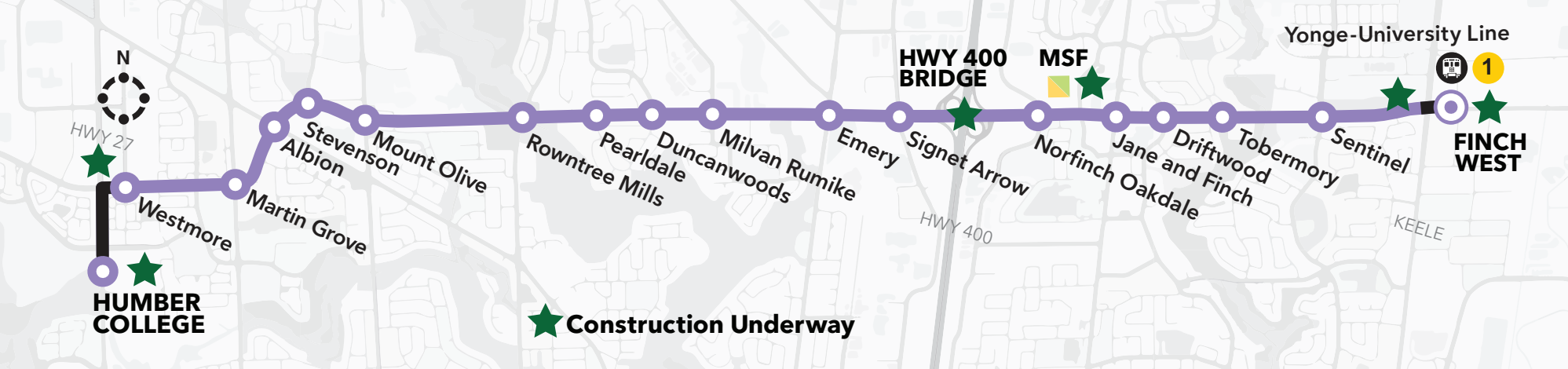

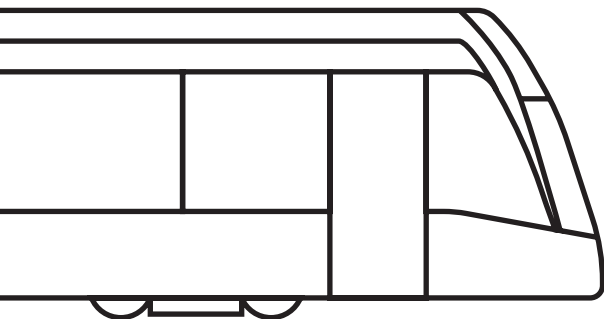
**Humber College Stop and Highway 27**

The Humber College stop is located on the southwest corner of Highway 27 and Humber College Blvd.

Before building it, we must move large and small utilities out of the way.

- Hydro poles, traffic signals and overhead wires will be relocated or moved to temporary poles.
- Aging watermains on Finch Ave. W., east of Hwy 27, will be demolished, replaced and moved, creating space for the LRT portal.
- A new storm sewer will also be installed along Highway 27.

If a short power or water shut-off is required, we will communicate to those directly affected.



**WINTER - SPRING 2020**

**Highway 400 Bridge**

The Highway 400 Bridge at Finch Ave. W. is being rehabilitated, and new decks constructed, then installed on the overpass, using a rapid bridge replacement method, thereby minimizing traffic disruptions.

Starting in January 2020, a crew will install two large steel scaffolding beside the highway. The two scaffoldings are strong enough to each hold the weight of 30 girders and an asphalt deck during its construction.

Throughout the winter, new decks will be constructed on the scaffolding for installation later this year. There will be periodic lane reductions at the on- and off-ramps to Highway 400.

**Maintenance and Storage Facility (MSF)**

Located at 50 York Gate Blvd., the MSF will be the centre of upkeep where light rail vehicles will be repaired, washed, and stored. Construction of the MSF site is underway. Foundation work continues in Winter 2020 and a steel structure for the MSF building will begin in Spring 2020.

**WINTER 2020**

**On Finch Avenue**

To prepare for the construction of the LRT line, Finch Ave. W. will be widened in each direction, between Tobermory Dr. and Tangiers Rd. We will first remove the topsoil and pavement, then place a layer of crushed stones and sand on the sub-surface before finally pouring new asphalt.

Above and underground utility lines and wires will be moved, rerouted or placed on temporary poles nearby. Traffic signals will be removed and replaced with temporary ones at these intersections: Finch Ave.-Keele St., as well as at Finch Ave.-Tangiers Rd.

**SPRING 2020**

**Finch West Station**

A new Finch West station will connect to the TTC subway at Finch Ave. and Keele St. via an underground pedestrian tunnel. Before excavating this underground station, a crew will install steel piles around the perimeter of the new station, tunnel, and emergency entrances. The steel piles will support the ground and nearby buildings during excavation.
